U. S. EXTENDS EXPORT LICENSES... Issues Them for 90, Instead of 60 Days. MERCHANTS' ASSOCIATION BROUGHT ABOUT CHANGE.

Declares That Without Extension It's Practically Impossible to Manufacture, Assemble and Prepare for Shipment the Merchandise in Question.

The War Trade Board has issued an order extending the period for which export licenses may be issued from 60 to 90 days.

The War Trade Board has announced that all export licenses issued after Jan. 22, 1918, shall be valid for a period of ninety days.

It is announced that the Bureau of Export Licenses has decided to issue a permit for a period not exceeding six months where the article to be exported must be specially manufactured and there is satisfactory evidence that more than ninety days are required for its manufacture and shipment.

FRENCH FAVOR JEWISH STATE

Government Makes Official Declaration. TARDIEU GETS MESSAGE FROM MINISTER PICHON

France and Britain in Accord About Palestine-Balfour's Letter on Matter to Lord Rothschild Induces Establishment of New State.

The French Government has made an official declaration in favor of a Jewish state in Palestine in accord with the British declaration to the same effect made by the British Cabinet on Nov. 2 last.

The Provisional Executive Committee for General Zionist Affairs has been authorized by M. Tardieu to make public the following message written on this subject: From M. Pichon to M. Tardieu, Feb. 12.

"I have seen M. Sokolow, I authorized him to state that, as regards the question, our views were essentially the same as the views entertained by the British Government. It was agreed upon that a Zionist delegation should be sent to Palestine."

"I beg you to notice the statement which I gave in the newspapers regarding the Zionist question. Naval raids from the press bureau of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs."

"I should be grateful if you would bring this declaration to the knowledge of the Zionist Federation."
